For children learning at home, lessons are set daily via the Class Dojo system. It's lovely to see all the fabulous work children are uploading. If you have any difficulties, please contact the class teacher or school to help you. If your child finds a piece of work difficult, please refer to any videos that have been attached or let them have a go so their teacher can see what they are struggling with. It is important that your child keeps doing their work and practising basic skills such as reading, number bonds, times tables and writing / handwriting. We still have a few lap tops available if your child is trying to work using your mobile phone. Also, we have a few SIM cards and Dongles if you are struggling for data.

We have just heard that school will not be reopening on 22nd February as we had hoped.

We have been following lots of rules and regulations now for a long time. It is important that we continue to do this to help protect our community. The NHS still say it is crucial we keep two metres apart, wear a face mask and wash or use a hand sanitiser regularly. Even though there are only a few children in school we still do all of these things as we want to keep everyone safe.
