Activity Days.

Next week F, KS1 and KS2 are going to be having some activity days in school where they get to try out some new sports. On these days we would like the children to come to school in PE kit and wearing trainers or pumps. Sports Days.

Wednesday 29th June in the afternoon at 1.30pm - KS1 sports.

Children can come to school in their PE kit on their sports day.

Parents are welcome to come and watch and will be admitted through the main gates at the bottom of the steps. We cannot man or keep the gates open all day so they will open at 9.15am until 9.45am and again when the sports end.

In the afternoon they will open at 1.15pm until 1.45pm and again when the sports end.

Parents can take photographs of their own children but please try to ensure you do not get other children in your shots as this is a breach of data protection.

Reports.

Children will be bringing their Records of Achievement home on Friday 8th July. We are hoping to include the outcomes of the Phonics Screening Test (Y1s), Y2 Sats and Y6 Sats. If these are not available we will send them out as soon as possible after this date. This will also tell you whose class your child will be in next year. We are holding our final open evening of the year on Wednesday 13th July. This will be an opportunity to view your child's work, have an informal chat with the teacher they have had this year and meet their new class teacher.

New classes.

From Monday 11th July the children will be registered in their existing class and then spend most of the day with their new teacher.
